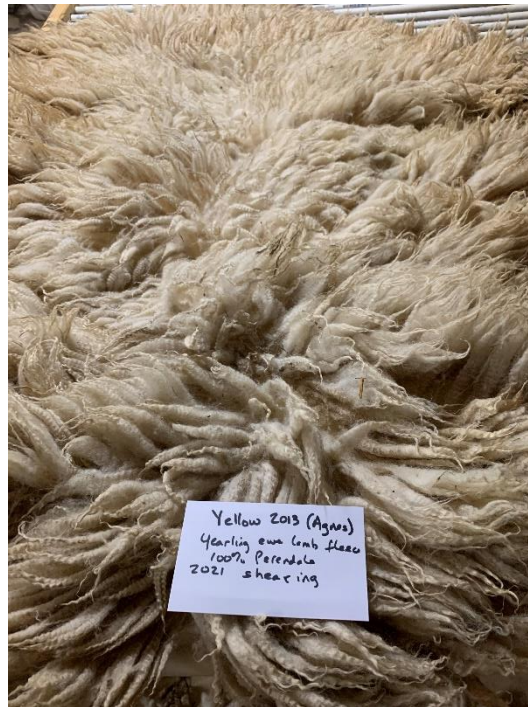


Agnes (Yellow 2013). 100% Perendale yearling lamb fleece. 5.4 lb, \$18/lb, 5-6" staple (unstretched), \$87.50 total (not including shipping) after 10% discount in case of fragile tips.

Agnes was named after a friend's pet sheep that thought she was a dog. Agnes' mother was purchased from California (where she was bred by Marta Sullivan of Currow Hill Ranch) as a six-year-old ewe. Agnes' fleece tested at a 33 micron count, with a 5-6" staple length. Agnes' fleece weighs 5.4 pounds skirted.

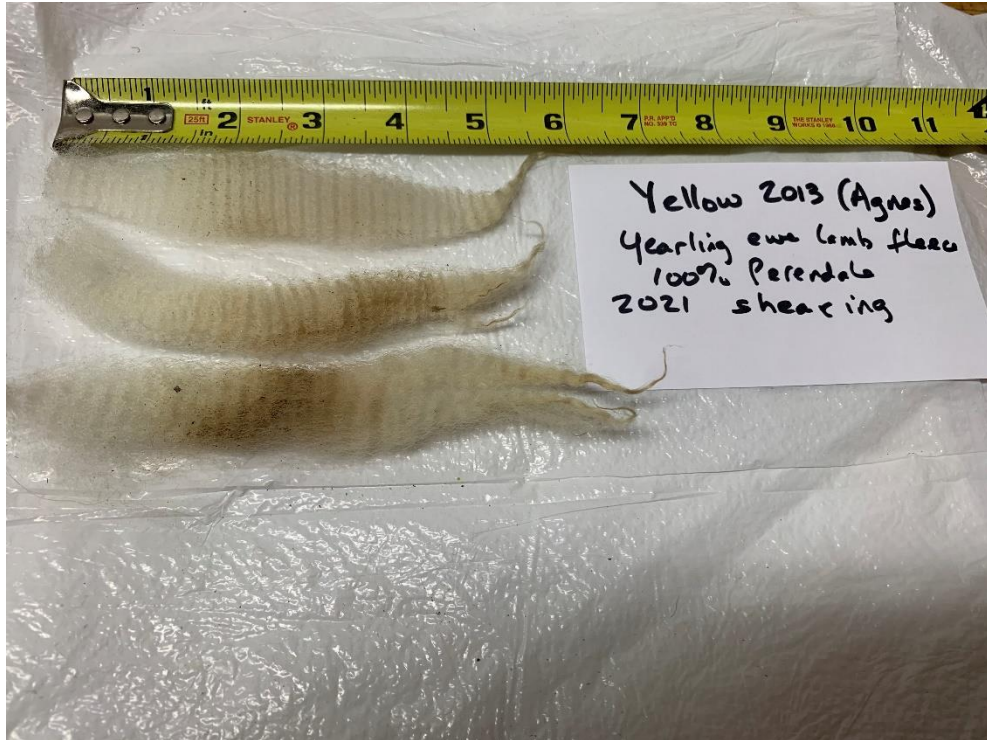

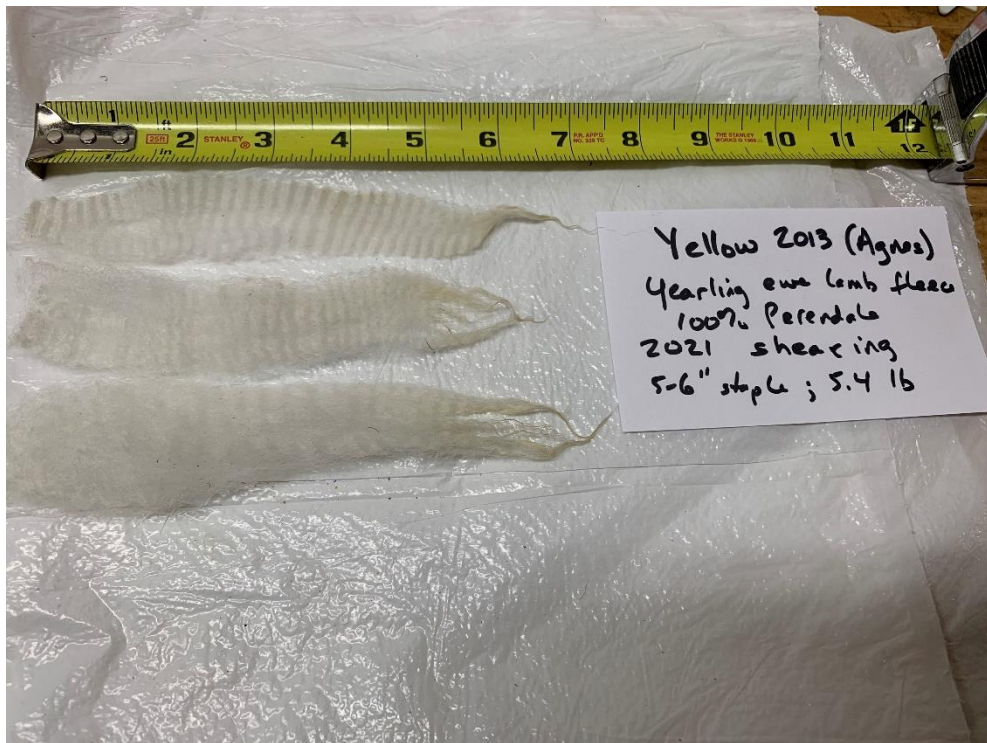

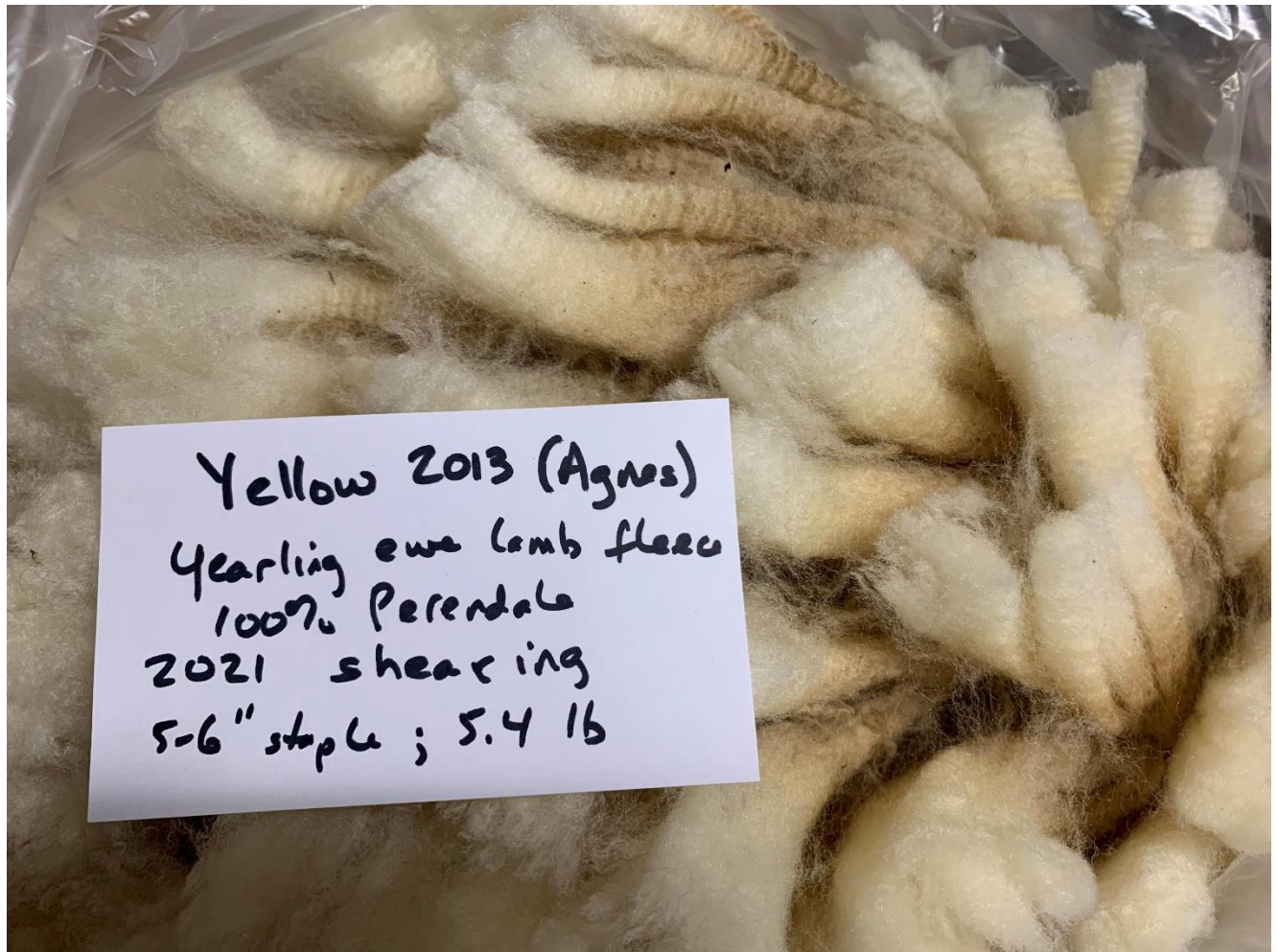
